**RESOLUTION BY
THE PIKES PEAK RURAL TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY
BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OPPOSING STATEWIDE BALLOT QUESTION PROPOSITION 101**

August 11, 2010

WHEREAS, the Pikes Peak Rural Transportation Authority is a legal entity comprised of the City of Colorado Springs, El Paso County, the City of Manitou Springs, the Town of Green Mountain Falls and the Town of Ramah; and

WHEREAS, the Pikes Peak Rural Transportation Authority provides local funding for capital, maintenance and public transportation projects and services; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 101 would reduce sales tax revenues for the Pikes Peak RTA and its capacity to deliver regional transportation projects by approximately \$1.8 million in 2011 increasing to \$4.8 million in 2014 and each year thereafter.

NOW, BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the Pikes Peak Rural Transportation Authority's Board of Directors does hereby declare its opposition to Proposition 101, which will appear on the November 2, 2010 general election ballot.
